The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order would be to reduce the 50mph speed limit and extend the 30mph speed limit on the following length of road in, Matfield Tunbridge Wells:

MAIDSTONE ROAD - From the south western boundary of Long Leas to a point in line with the north eastern boundary of Tarpil Hus.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on day of 2021 and may be cited as 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tunbridge Wells) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020 (Amendment No.6) Order 2021' ('this Order').
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tunbridge Wells) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020' ('the Order of 2020') shall have effect as though:
